Goygol District. Goygol (Azerbaijani: Göygöl) is a rayon (district) in northwestern Azerbaijan. Formerly known as Khanlar, the region was renamed "Goygol" after Lake Goygol, the famous blue lake, by the decision of the Parliament of Azerbaijan on April 25, 2008. Ganja is a city found in Ganja City, Azerbaijan. It is located 40.68 latitude and 46.36 longitude and it is situated at elevation 417 meters above sea level. Ganja is Azerbaijan's second-largest city with a population of around 1.000.000 It was named Elisabethpol in the Russian Empire period. The city regained its original name Ganja in 1920 during the first part of its incorporation into the Soviet Union. - City Maps Ganja Azerbaijan
