DALLAS TERMINAL RAILWAY. The Dallas Terminal Railway and Union Depot Company was chartered on December 10, 1894, to build north from Dallas for twenty miles to a connection with the St. Louis Southwestern Railway Company of Texas between Plano and Fort Worth. CRAMER, Justice. This was an action for damages for personal injuries sustained by Hannah Jarvis, wife of appellee, when she fell while alighting from the side exit door of one of appellant's busses. Chaney, Davenport & Harless, Dallas, for respondent. CALVERT, Justice. Respondent, Lewis A. Jarvis, is the husband of Hannah Jarvis, and by his suit against Dallas Railway & Terminal Company, petitioner, sought damages for injuries to his wife. Dallas Railway And Terminal Co. v. Farnsworth 148 Tex. 584, 227 S.w.2d 1017 (1950) Action for damages on account of injuries suffered by respondent, Mrs. Letta M.
