

# **Download Davis V. United States Gypsum Co.**

United States Antitrust law is a collection of federal and state government laws that regulates the conduct and organization of business corporations, generally to promote fair competition for the benefit of consumers. United States Department of Justice's PlainSite profile, including litigation, intellectual property, public records and more. The GHGRP generally requires facilities that emit above 25,000 metric tons CO<sub>2</sub>e of GHGs to report their emissions.
