"Big Two-Hearted River" is a two-part short story written by American author Ernest Hemingway, published in the 1925 Boni & Liveright edition of *In Our Time*, the first American volume of Hemingway's short stories. Ernest Hemingway did more to influence the style of English prose than any other writer of his time. Publication of *The Sun Also Rises* and *A Farewell to Arms* immediately established him as one of the greatest literary lights of the 20th century. The Two Hearted River is a river in the eastern Upper Peninsula of the U.S. state of Michigan. The river runs approximately 23.6 miles (38.0 km) through forested wilderness, and drains into Lake Superior. Hadley Richardson, Hemingway's first wife.
